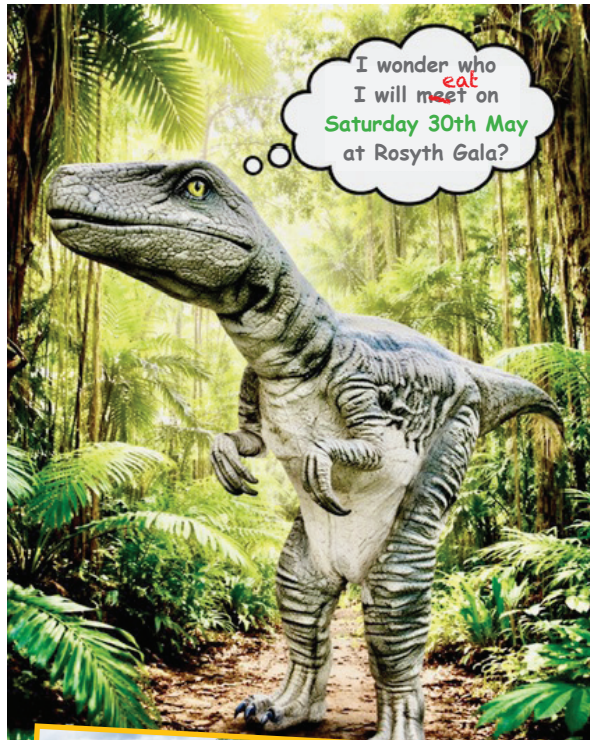
## IT'S OUR SPECIAL ANNIVERSARY

THE SUN SHONE brightly on Saturday 30 May 2016, when 5,000 people turned out for the first Gala to be held in Rosyth for 30 years as part of the celebrations to mark 100 years since Rosyth was established as Scotland's only garden city.

The Centenary Gala Day included a parade, daredevil stunts, dynamic gymnastics, dance groups and live music, with local stallholders and community groups taking part. The event was hailed as a great success and is now an annual event in Rosyth Public Park.

Since 2021, it has been organised under the wing of Rosyth Community Projects Ltd, who deliver a lively, family-oriented event, with a strong community focus and a mix of traditional fairground fun, displays, local entertainment and musicians. This year is the 10th anniversary.

Be sure to come and enjoy the day, but it would be great if you would also consider volunteering.

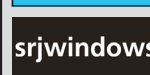
